Having captured this information; explain how you have verified the dimensions and volume measurement and derived tolerances for them and present your results in a single PowerPoint slide or PDF to be submitted to the conference organisers by e-mail (adam.thompson@nottingham.ac.uk) before 17:00 (GMT) Friday 14th May 2021.

A prize, in the form of gift vouchers, is on offer to the best reasoned and presented results, as voted for by the conference attendees and will be awarded at the end of the conference on the 19th May 2021.
