Things to do near Teddington

19th July –14th September - BBC Proms 2019 (Standing Tickets £6)

Eight-week summer season of daily orchestral classical music concerts and other events held at Royal Albert Hall

July –September – Visit Buckingham Palace (Tickets £25)

Explore the lavish interiors of the Queen's official London residence, and one of the world's few remaining working royal palaces

3rd August – Prudential RideLondon FreeCycle (Free – registration required)

The circuit passes iconic London landmarks including Buckingham Palace, Trafalgar Square, St Paul's Cathedral and the Bank of England, with stunning views of London to be found everywhere you look.

25th August – Notting Hill Carnival (Free)

The streets of west London come alive every August bank holiday weekend with a huge Caribbean party at Europe's biggest street festival.

Things to do near Strathclyde

2nd – 24th August 2019 – Edinburgh Military Tattoo (Tickets £25)

Spectacular event set against the backdrop of Edinburgh Castle. Hailed as one of the most spectacular shows in the world and watched by a TV audience of 100 million worldwide.

2nd –26th August – Edinburgh Fringe Festival (Ticket Free or show cost)

The world's biggest celebration of the arts. Runs for three weeks with a mix of culture and art, theatre, music and dance, exhibitions, children's shows and events.

11th August – Pedal for Parkinson's (Stirling) (£25 registration for 25 miles)

A 25 or 60 mile cycle challenge around historic Stirling. Have an active day out with your friends and family, while supporting a worthwhile cause, Parkinson's UK

16th – 17th August World Pipe Band Championships (Ticket £5)

The World Pipe Band Championships are back with around 8000 pipers and drummers taking part at Glasgow Green
